NJ State Sanitary Code, amended December 14, 2007, requires that students must meet immunization requirements as set forth in Chapter 14. Regulation 4:16 requires that all students entering the sixth grade receive one dose of **Tdap** no earlier than their 10th birthday and one dose of **meningococcal vaccine**, along with a physical exam.

Documentation of vaccination & Physical are due by the start of school next year or the child will not be permitted to enter the building. Your child's primary care provider must complete the form below along with a physical form to be brought to Bloomsbury Elementary School by **August 1st.** If your child has a summer physical after August 1st, please contact the health office to provide the date of the physical.
